### Team Selection

In coming weeks Coaches/Managers will be in touch to advise specific details associated with their Teams, including any training in Canberra prior to the Championships and confirmation of the date everyone will need to be in location for pre-Championship Training, meetings, etc. Coaches or Managers will be the player's first point of contact from here on.

### ACT Masters Hockey Membership

As advised in the announcements concerning the nomination process, and on the ACT Masters website, membership of ACT Masters Hockey Association is a pre-requisite of playing, managing and coaching ACT Masters Teams. We charge a very nominal fee (\$24.08), compared to all other States.

If you are not already a member or have not renewed, please sign-up ASAP as your National ID Number and current financial membership details are required before we can lodge team entries on-line with Hockey Australia. If you already hold a current, financial membership of another State Masters Assn or Club and have paid the HA Levy already in 2023 you will NOT be charged this again when you go through the ACT Masters membership enrolment/renewal process.

Interstate players should select Option 7 "Interstate Registered Player Attending Nationals" as the membership type.



Coaches, Managers and Medical Support Staff should select Option 8 “Interstate non-playing member attending Nationals”.

### **Team Levy**

Each player is required to pay the Player Team Levy. The levy covers the team’s entry fee, Medical Support Staff, support staff, trophies and gifts for opposition teams and best and fairest trophies for ACT Teams. The Team Levy for 2023 will be advised shortly once confirmation of team entry costs is received from HA. This year’s levy is expected to be approx \$650. You should already have paid the \$250 deposit, which was due on nominating. You will be issued an invoice for the balance owing shortly. All levy payments will be due by 15<sup>th</sup> July 2022.

It is vital to put your name and team as a reference.

The ACT Masters Hockey Committee is confident that the Master’s Championships for 2023 will proceed and planning is well under way. If the Tournament is cancelled the ACT Masters Hockey Committee will arrange a refund (or part thereof) of the Player Levy depending on the timing of the cancellation of the Championships.

The normal expenses incurred by ACT Masters Hockey will be delayed as much as possible, to enable the maximum refund to be paid. To assist our players and limit any player’s loss, ACT Masters Hockey is prepared to cover a substantial part of any potential loss. However, a small percentage of any lost will need to be supported by our players as well to ensure our ongoing viability.

If the Championships are cancelled the following refund policy will apply to the Player Levy:

- If cancelled before the 22<sup>nd</sup> August 2023 100% refund of Levy.
- If cancelled after the 22<sup>nd</sup> August 2023 90% refund of Levy.



## Accommodation

The Accommodation Coordinator will contact those who indicated they wished to be included in the accommodation organised by the Association. It is imperative you respond promptly to any request for information and payment as strict deadlines have been applied by the accommodation providers, and non-payments or late changes may result in cancellation fees being charged. Where these result from a lack of response by a player the fee will be passed on for payment.

## Team Uniform Requirements

Clive Sear, the Association Team Uniform Coordinator, will be in contact to confirm playing uniform and associated clothing requirements.

These, too, will have strict deadlines for dates to advise your requirements. All uniform requirements must be ordered by **30<sup>th</sup> JUNE 2023**.

There are national shortages and ordering/production delays in a variety of industries and sports clothing is one of them. Early responses to requests will ensure we aren't left with any difficulties prior to the Championships.
